**All Students:** Asset may only be taken once every 12 months. Students must use a combination of their writing and reading scores for placement into their first English course. **Running Start:** Applicants qualifying for English 101 (college level writing AND college level reading) meet admission requirements for non-math courses. Applicants qualifying for Math 107/119 or above meet admission requirements for math courses. College level math placement is not required for Running Start admission. Students must meet all other program eligibility requirements and submit a Running Start application to the Running Start office. For more information call 360.475.7646.
