**All Students:** Students must use a combination of their writing and reading scores to be placed into their first English course. Students may take no more than 2 assessments in one calendar year. Placement scores are valid for 2 years.

**Running Start:** Applicants qualifying for English 101 (college level writing AND college level reading) meet admission requirements for non-math courses. Applicants qualifying for Math 107/119 or above meet admission requirements for math courses. College level math placement is not required for Running Start admission. Students must meet all other program eligibility requirements and submit a Running Start application to the Running Start office. For more information call 360.475.7646.

**PSNS:** Applicants are responsible for submitting scores to PSNS. Minimum acceptable scores: 77 Writing, 81 Reading AND 46 Pre-Algebra.
